Deer that are caped or skinned before photos are taken are of eligible for entry. Digital photos should be at least 1 megabyte in size. Your photo may appear in ion, so take the time to get quality shots. Poor photos will not be published. On a separate sheet of paper, write a description of your hunt. Read the rules of the Truck-Buck contest. Then sign and date this entry form at the bottom. Along with this Official Entry Form and the written hunt story, mail at least three of your favorite photos ryou with the deer. GON cannot return these photos. The entire entry must be received by GON within even (7) business days of the date the buck was killed. We strongly recommend online entry or next-apy priority mail. A missed deadline means the buck is disqualified from the contest. Remove or have your taxidermist remove the rack so that only the antlers attached to the skull plate attached to the skull plate and in on the photographer's back.
